**SUGGESTED IDLE REDUCTION EDUCATION PLAN BY CALIFORNIA STATE
AGENCY
SUCH AS THE AIR RESOURCES BOARD**

In the interest of effectiveness, a California vehicle idling regulation that includes passenger vehicles will require educational outreach to California's 24 million passenger vehicle motorists. The following suggestions can also be shared with California air districts, and environmental and health organizations.

- California state agency (such as ARB) idle reduction webpage; twelve other state agencies have webpages or documents that include passenger vehicle idle reduction education; see below
- California state agency (such as ARB) passenger vehicle idle reduction video; example: East Bay Clean Cities "To Idle or Not to Idle" <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PTbJrEbxs64>
- Collaboration with the DMV to list idle reduction as a fuel-efficient driving tip in the CA Drivers' Handbook and to include it as a driver exam test question
- Collaboration with the DMV to include idle reduction information rack cards at all DMV locations
- Collaboration with CAPCOA in consideration of air districts providing idle reduction education on their websites and in documents
- Collaboration with the California Dept. of Education to promote such a regulation in the school community
- Issuing of news releases about this initiative
